To all,

The National Weather Service has issued a *Excessive Heat Warning*; this is the threshold to start regular communications in response to the excessive heat coming tomorrow and Friday. The warning is issued when Heat Index values are expected to exceed 105F two days in a row with the Heat Index not expected to drop below 75F at night.

We will be hosting an Excessive Heat Events **conference call Thursday 7/21 at 1:00pm. Dial 888 / 363-4734** and enter **access code 5055466**. Please expect an additional call on Friday 7/22.

The purpose for this call is to ensure that we all have an awareness of conditions / vulnerabilities in relation to the heat and that we can identify and address heat related needs. While the call may not last long, experience has taught us that the earlier we build situational awareness and establish incident-specific communication networks, the better emergency response goes.
