ORDINANCE NO. 1/2000

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF VIENNA PERTAINING TO
ELECTION POLLING HOURS AND SPLITTING ELECTION OFFICIALS
INTO TWO SHIFTS AT THE TOWN OF VIENNA POLLS

Whereas the Town of Vienna is a municipality which maintains a polling location to collect ballots for all federal, state, county, school district, and local elections; and

Whereas the Town of Vienna appoints election officials from the municipality to work as election and poll workers in the collection and reporting of the ballots received at such elections; and


Whereas the Town Board of the Town of Vienna, pursuant to sec. 6.78, Wis. Stats., desires that the polls at any election be open from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m.; and

Whereas the Town Board of the Town of Vienna desires that two shifts be established for election officials and poll workers to accommodate the increase polling hours;

Now, therefore, the Town Board of the Town of Vienna, Dane County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

1. Polling Hours: That the polling hours of the Town of Vienna be changed to the hours 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. for all elections;
2. Shifts for Election Officials: That the Town of Vienna hereby establishes two shifts for election officials and poll workers as allowed by Wisconsin election laws; and
3. Effective Date: That this ordinance shall be effective for all future elections upon notice of the change of hours being given by publication in a newspaper, under ch. 985, Wis. Stats., once week for two successive weeks, with the first insertion not less than eight days before the election.


The above and foregoing ordinance was duly adopted by the Town Board of the Town of Vienna at a regular meeting held on the 17 day of January, 2000.
