

ORDINANCE NO. 3-1-10-1

ORIGINAL

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF VIENNA  
TO REGULATE PUBLIC ON-STREET PARKING

The Town Board of the Town of Vienna, Dane County, Wisconsin, pursuant to authority vested in it, does hereby ordain as follows:

**SECTION 1. PROHIBITION**

It shall be unlawful for any person to park, stop, or leave standing any vehicle except temporarily for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading or in receiving or discharging passengers and while the vehicle is attended by a licensed operator so that it may be moved promptly in case of an emergency or to avoid obstruction of traffic at the following locations: along the westerly side of Hilltop Circle at any time or along the easterly side of Hilltop Circle between November 1 and May 1 of each year.

**SECTION 2. CITATION**

The Town Board or its designated representative may issue a citation for a forfeiture penalty in violation of this Ordinance. In addition, the Town Board or its designated representative or any other traffic officer is authorized and empowered to remove or have such vehicle removed to a position where parking is permitted.


**SECTION 3. PENALTY**


In addition to such other penalties and remedies that may apply, any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be subject to a forfeiture of not more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100). Illegally parked vehicles shall also be towed and removed at the expense of the owner of the vehicle.

**SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE**

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect on and after publication. The Town Clerk shall properly post or publish this Ordinance as required under sec. 60.80, Wis. Stats.


