ORDINANCE NO. 4-20-09-1

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF VIENNA  
TO CREATE FIVE (5) MEMBER TOWN BOARD**

WHEREAS, the Town of Vienna, Dane County, Wisconsin, has been authorized by the town electors to exercise village powers pursuant to ss. 60.10(2)(c) and 60.22(3), Wis. Stats.; and

WHEREAS, s. 60.21(1), Wis. Stats., authorizes town boards with village powers to establish a five (5) member town board; and

WHEREAS, the electors at the Town's annual meeting on April 14, 2009, and the Town Board have both determined that a five (5) person town board would provide greater representation to the residents of the Town of Vienna;


NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of Vienna, pursuant to sec. 60.21.(1), Wis. Stats., elects and ordains to increase the number of town supervisors for the Town of Vienna from (3) to five (5) members and further ordains that the five (5) member town board for the Town of Vienna shall be created as follows:


For the spring election in April, 2010, there will be a chair and four (4) supervisors. Two (2) supervisors shall be elected in the even numbered years and three (3) supervisors shall be elected in the odd numbered years. An increase in the number of town board supervisors does not create a vacancy on the Town Board.

This ordinance shall be effective after a public hearing, adoption by the Town Board of the Town of Vienna, and publication.

The foregoing ordinance was duly adopted at a regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Vienna on April 20<sup>th</sup>, 2009.


