

ORDINANCE 11-18-19
ESTABLISHING FREQUENCY OF FIRE INSPECTIONS
WAUNAKEE AREA FIRE DISTRICT

The Town Board of the Town of Vienna, Dane County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. INTRODUCTION.

- A. Authority: This ordinance is adopted pursuant to the general authority granted town boards under s. 60.55 Wis. Stats. Fire Protection
- B. Purpose: It shall be the duty of the Waunakee Area Fire Chief or his or her designee to inspect all public buildings and premises at least once per calendar year pursuant to WI Admin. Code and SPS 314.01(13)7, except the interiors of private dwelling units, or as often as may be deemed necessary for the purpose of ascertaining and causing to be corrected any conditions found to be contrary to the adoptions and references found in this code or any other applicable law. In no case shall the period between inspections exceed fifteen (15) months.

SECTION 2. SCOPE

- A. Local ordinances for reducing the frequency of inspections: SPS 314.01(13)7
Where authorized by local ordinance, a city, village, or town may reduce the inspections required under subd. 3. To at least once per calendar year, provided the interval between those inspections does not exceed 15 months.
- B. Scheduling of Inspections: SPS 314.01(13)3. Fire prevention inspections shall be conducted at least once in each non-overlapping 6-month period per calendar year, or more often if ordered by the Waunakee fire chief, in all territory served by the Waunakee fire department, except as provided in subds. 4. to 7.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE: This ordinance shall become effective upon adoption and posting, as provided by law, pursuant to s. 60.80, Wis. Stat.
